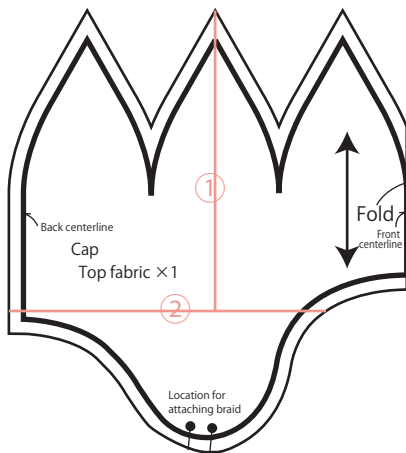

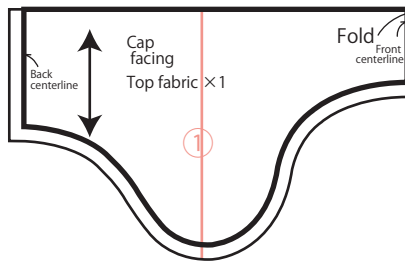
Cap

* Join Cap a, Cap b and Cap c at the joining lines to create a single pattern. ① and ②

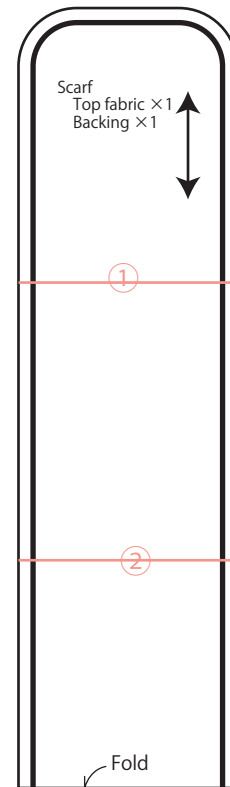
Cap facing

★ The cap requires 2 patterns.

Scarf

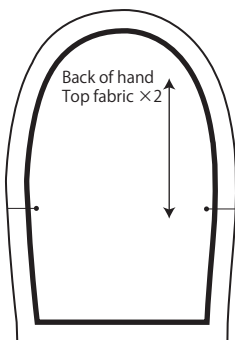


* Join Scarf a, Scarf b and Scarf c at the joining lines to create a single pattern. ① and ②

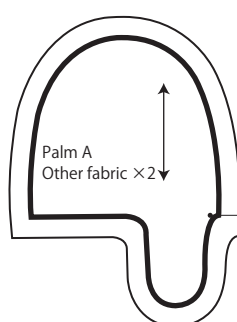
★ The scarf requires 1 pattern.

Mittens

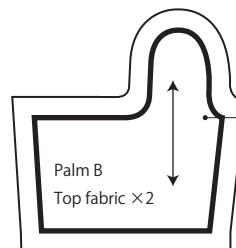
Back of hand



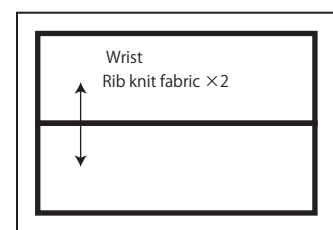
Palm A

★ The mittens require 4 patterns.

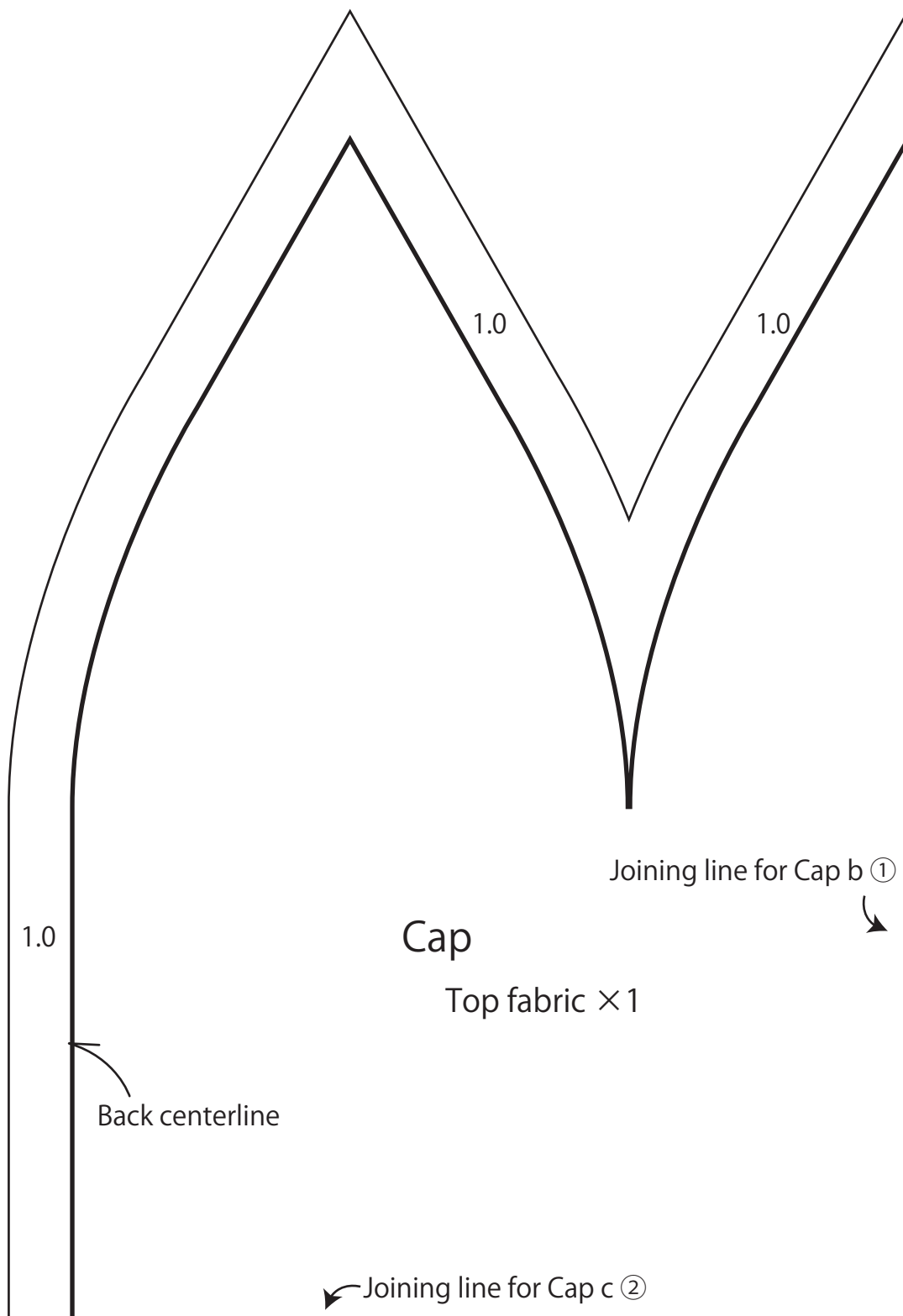
* The basic seam allowance is 1.0 cm.

* ——— Stitching line

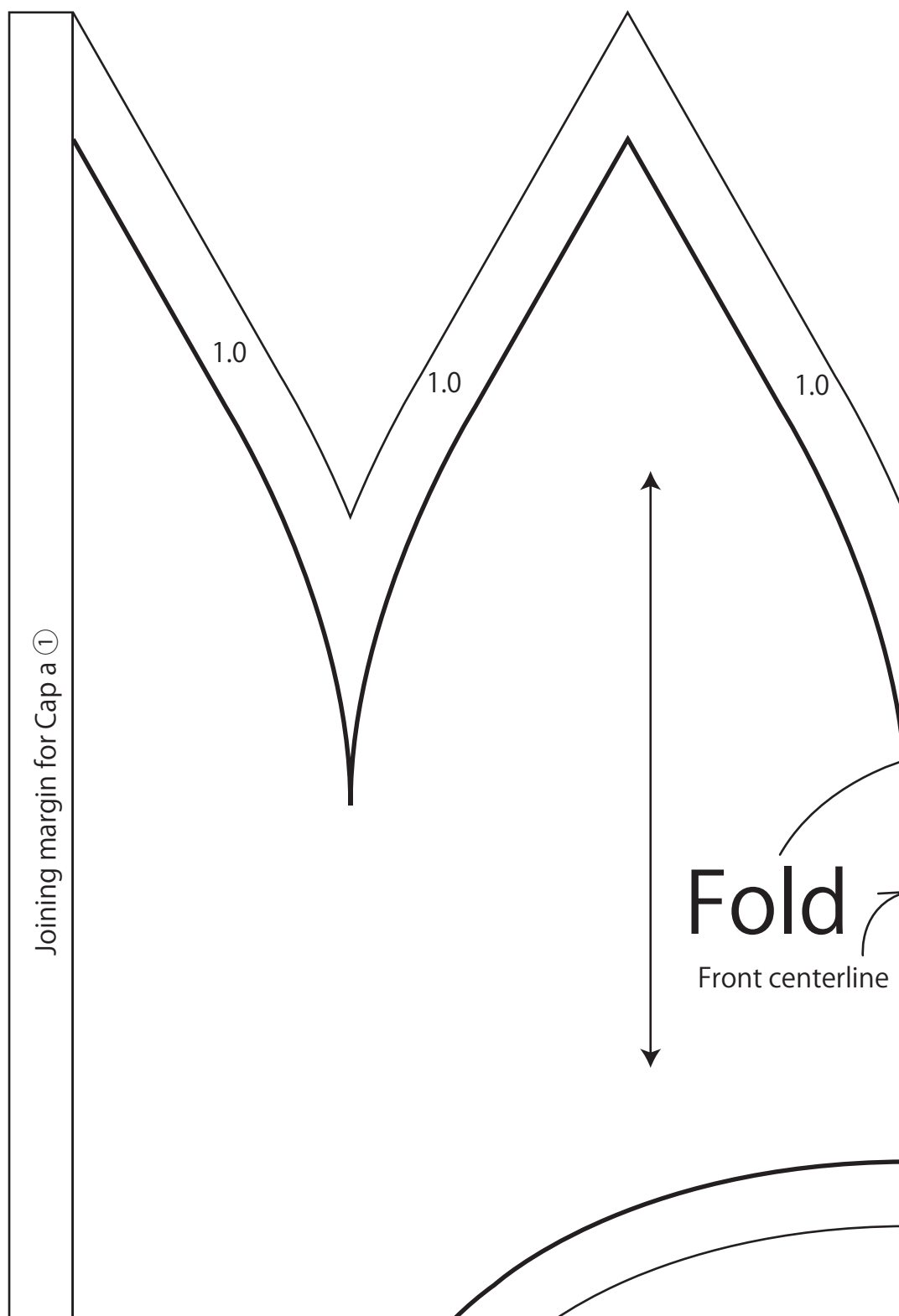
* Arrows indicate the direction of the fabric grain.

Cap a



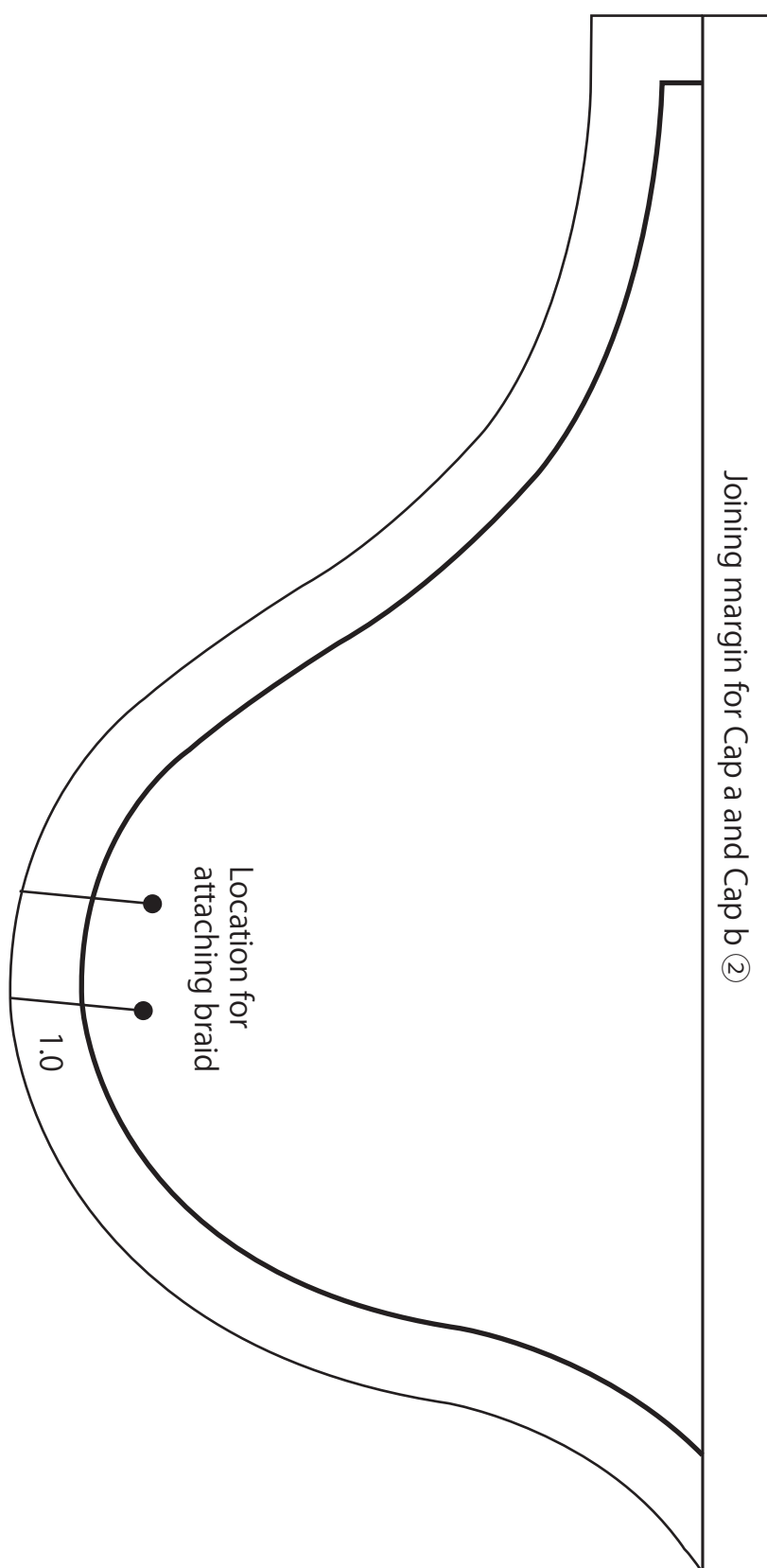
* Join Cap a, Cap b and Cap c at the joining lines to create a single pattern. ① and ②

Cap b



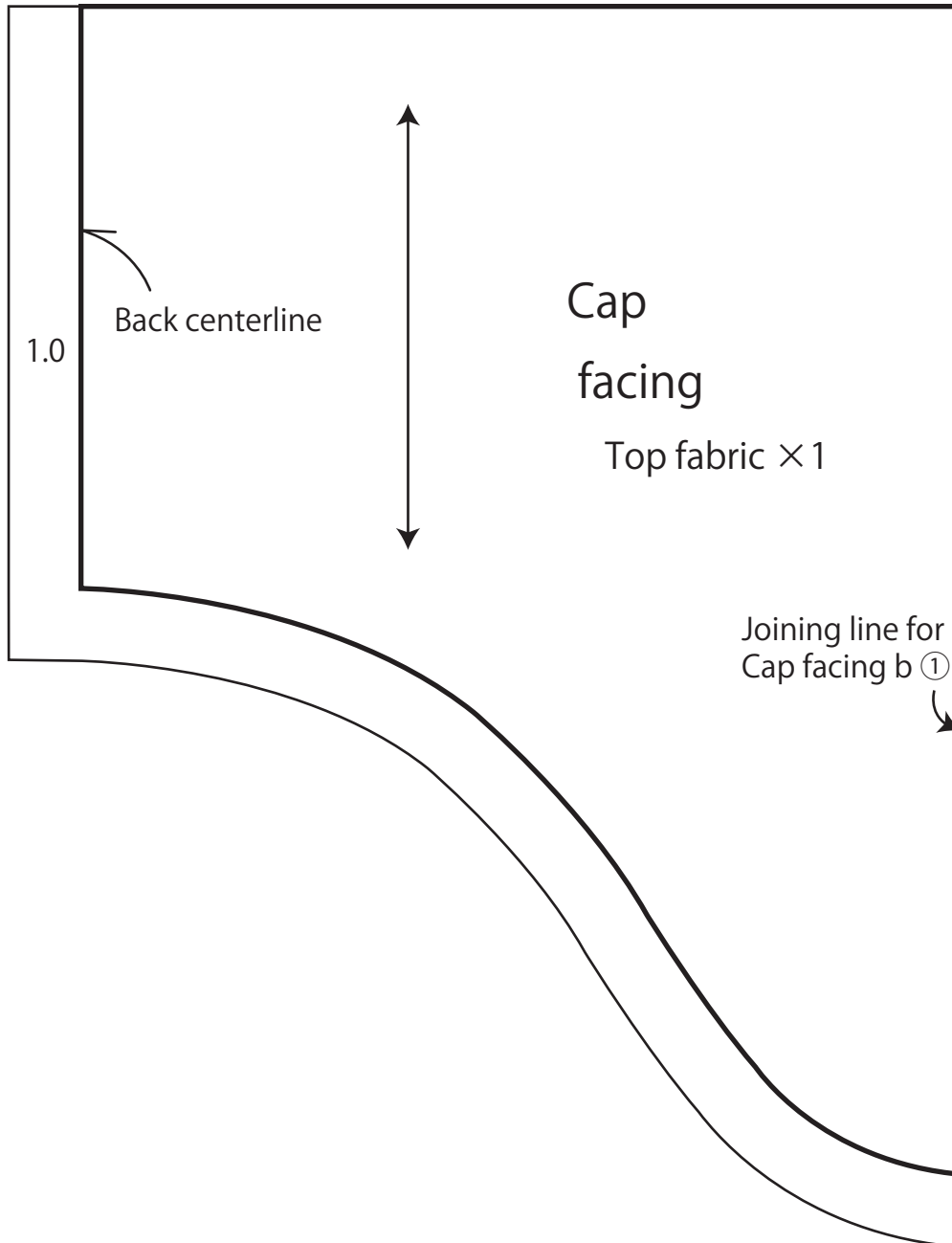
* Join Cap a, Cap b and Cap c at the joining lines

Cap c



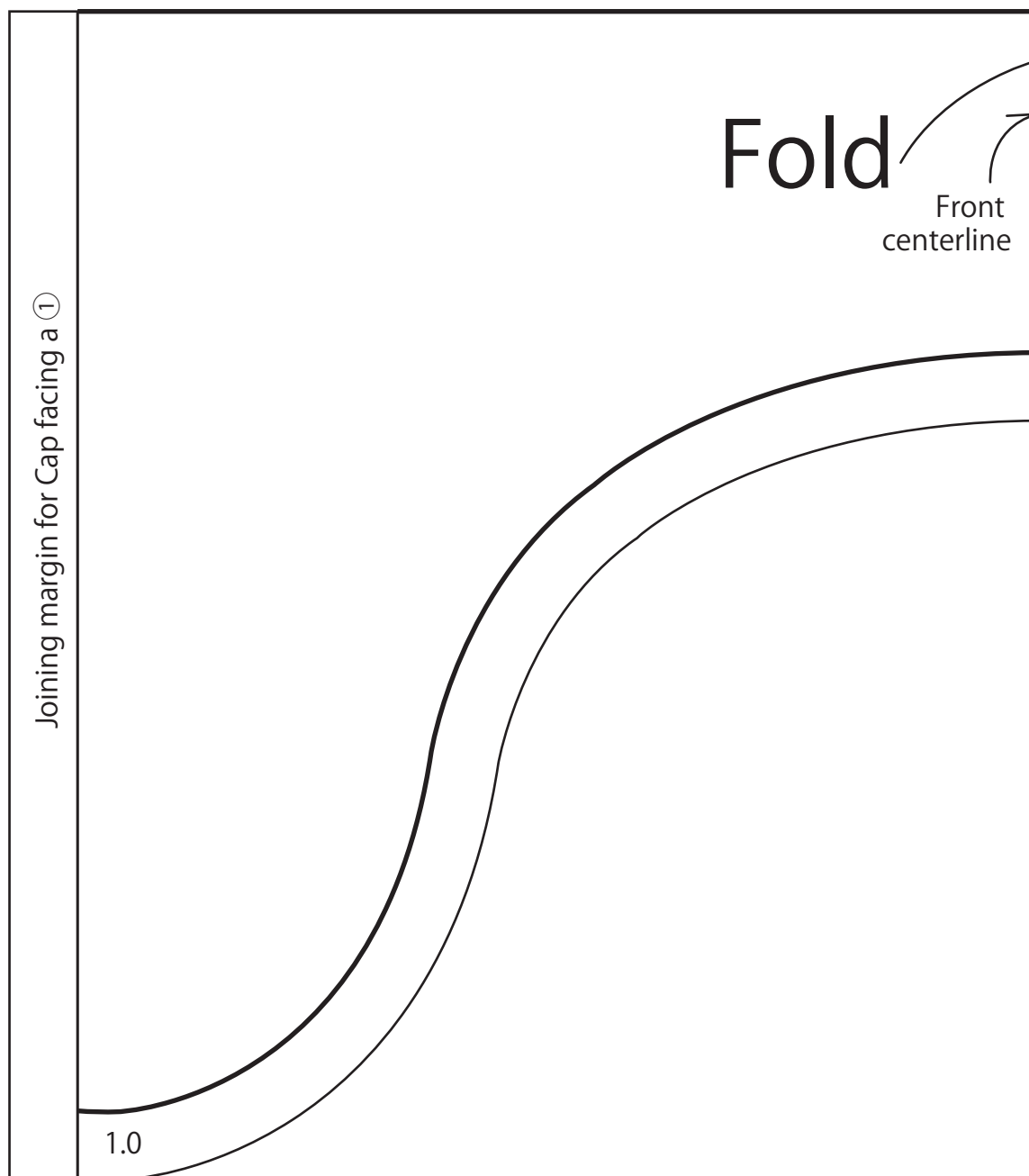
* Join Cap a, Cap b and Cap c at the joining lines to create a single pattern. ① and ②

Cap facing a



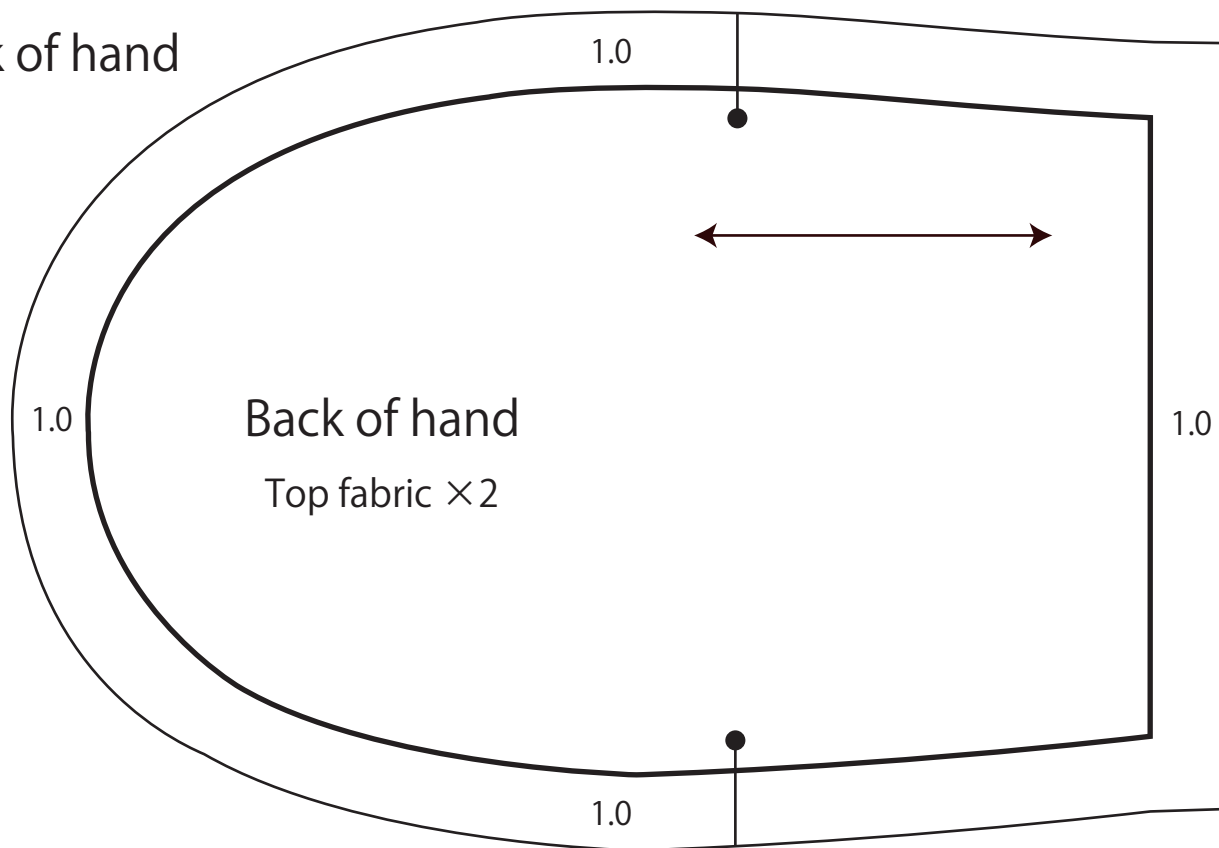
* Join Cap facing a and Cap facing b at the joining lines to create a single pattern. ①

Cap facing b

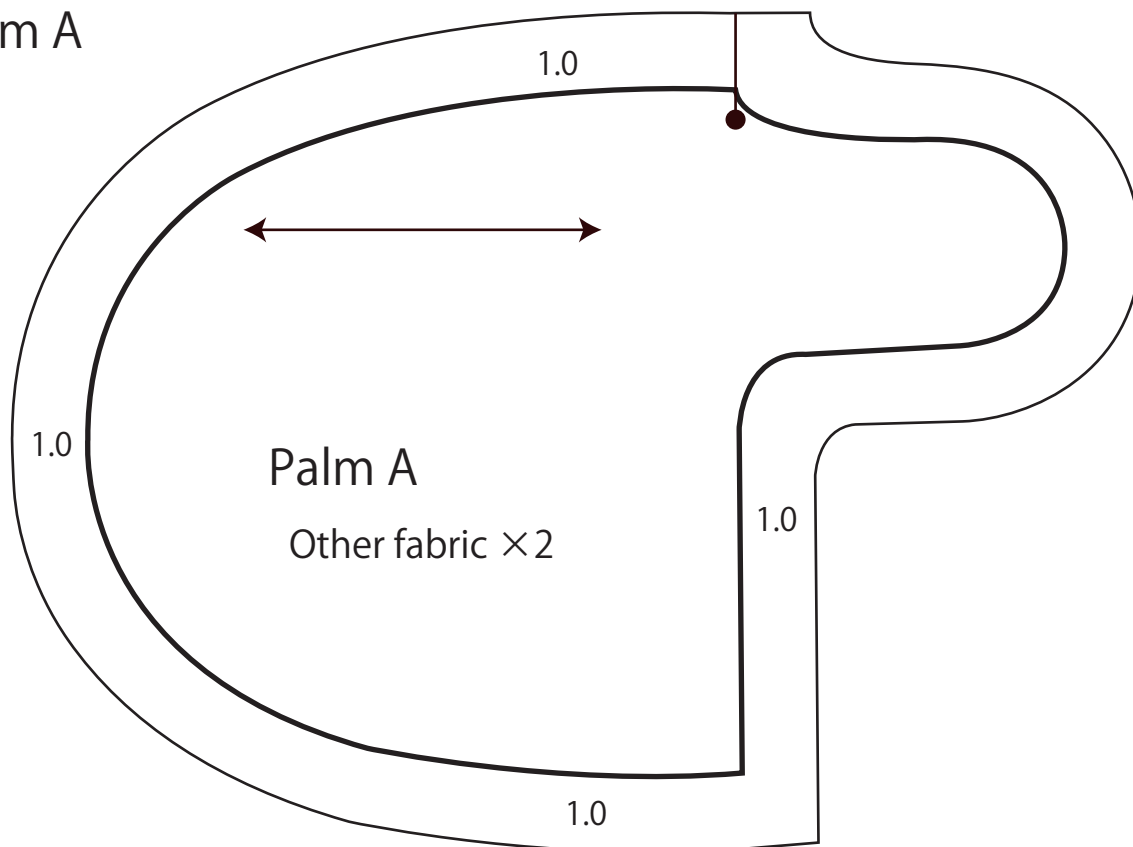


* Join Cap facing a and Cap facing b at the joining lines to create a single pattern. ①

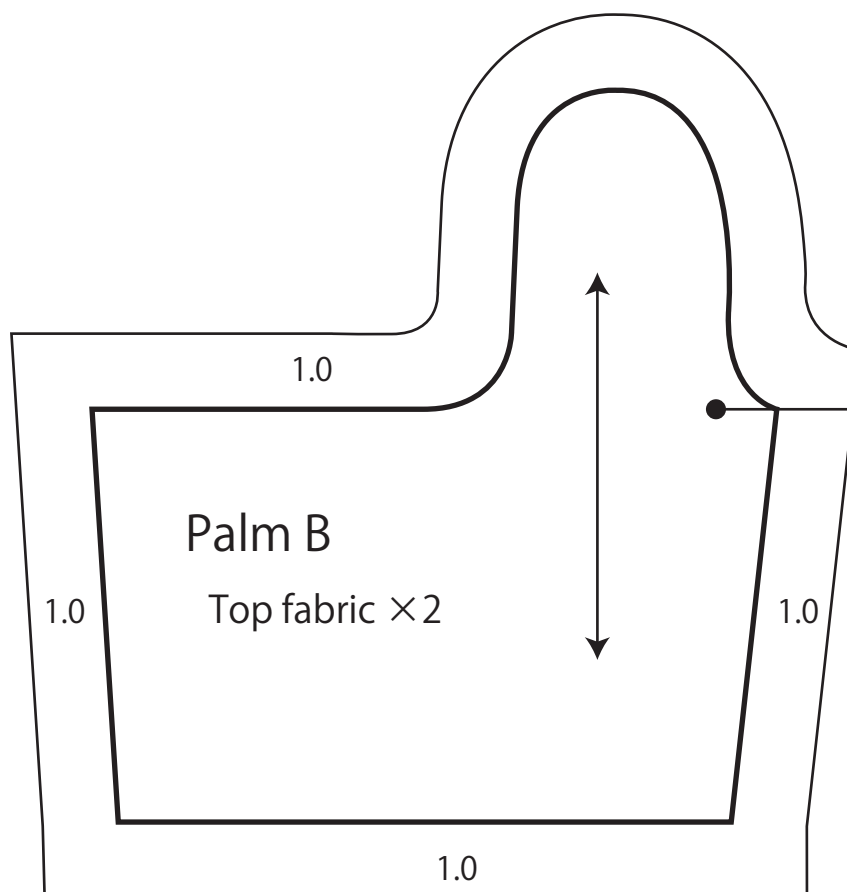

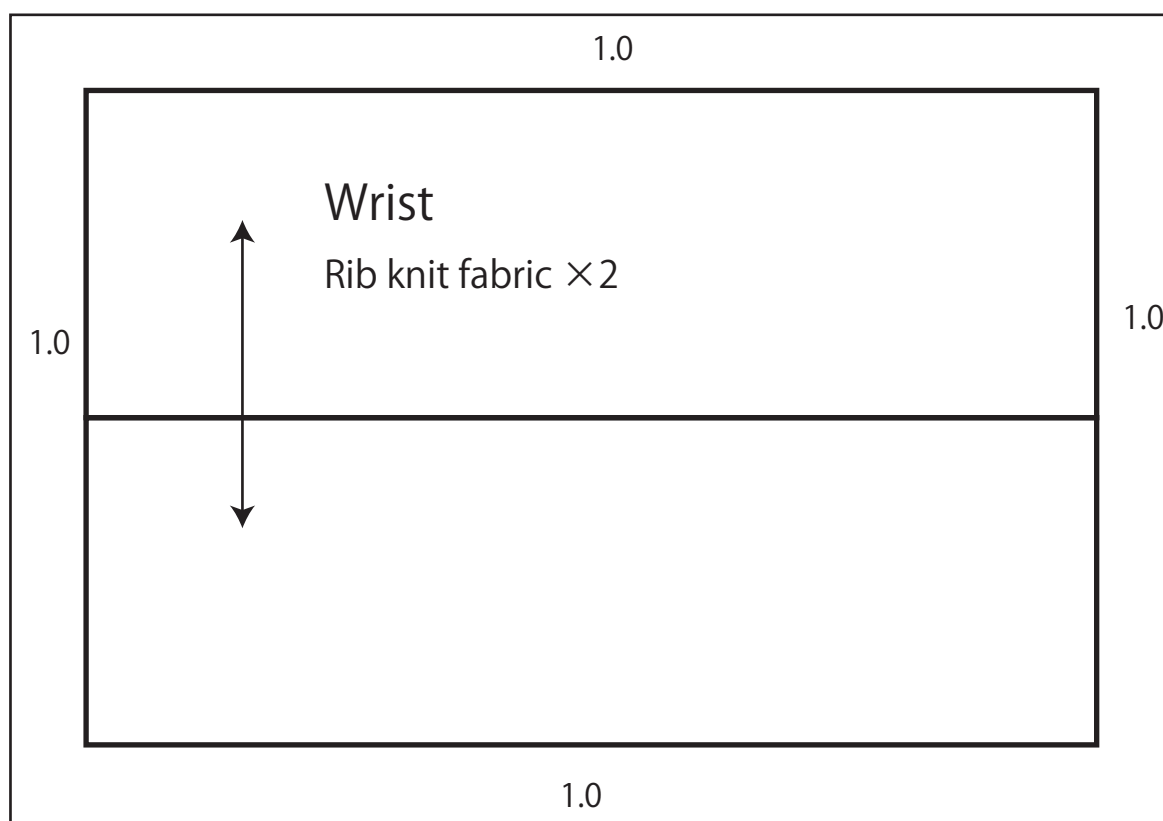
Palm A



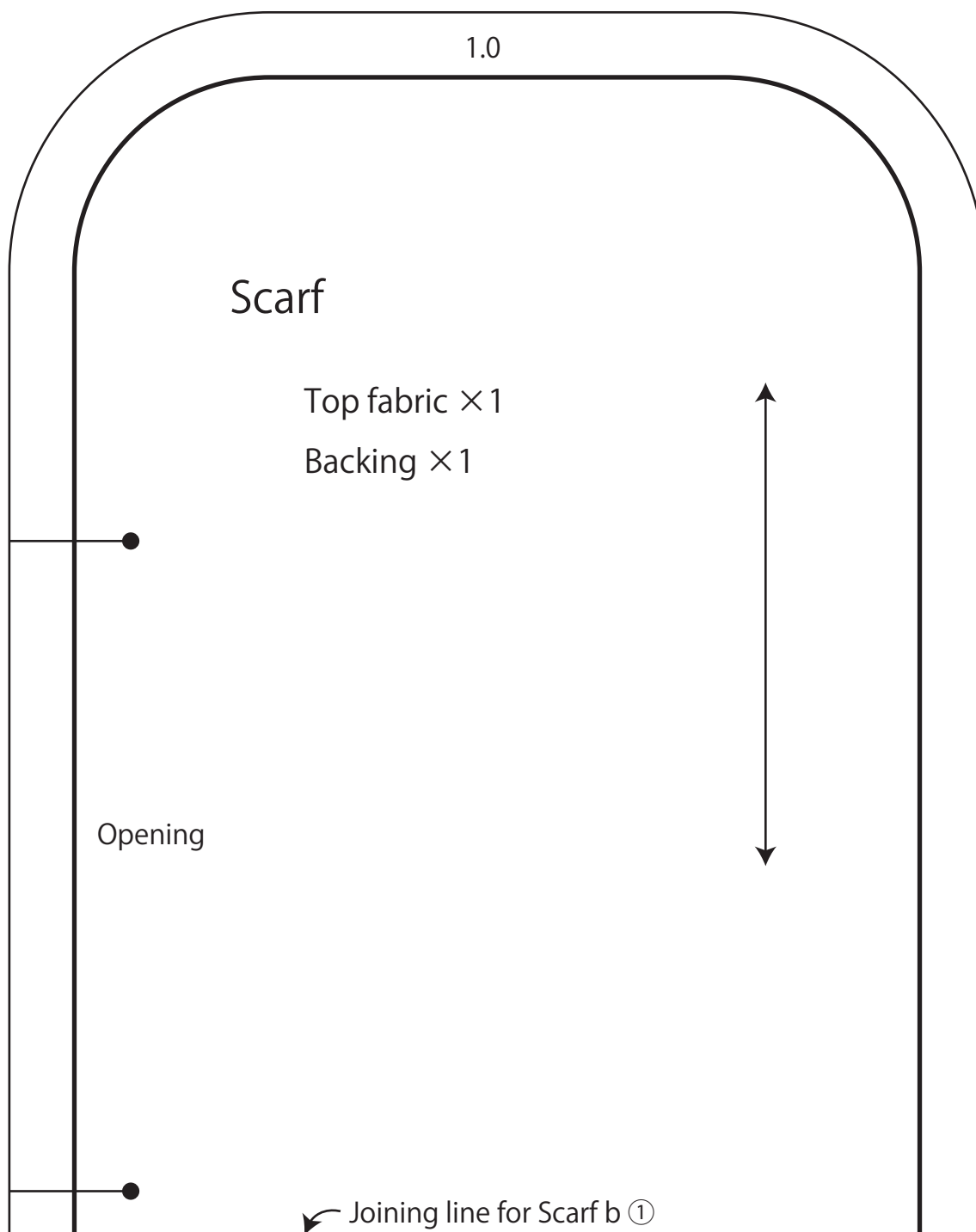

Wrist

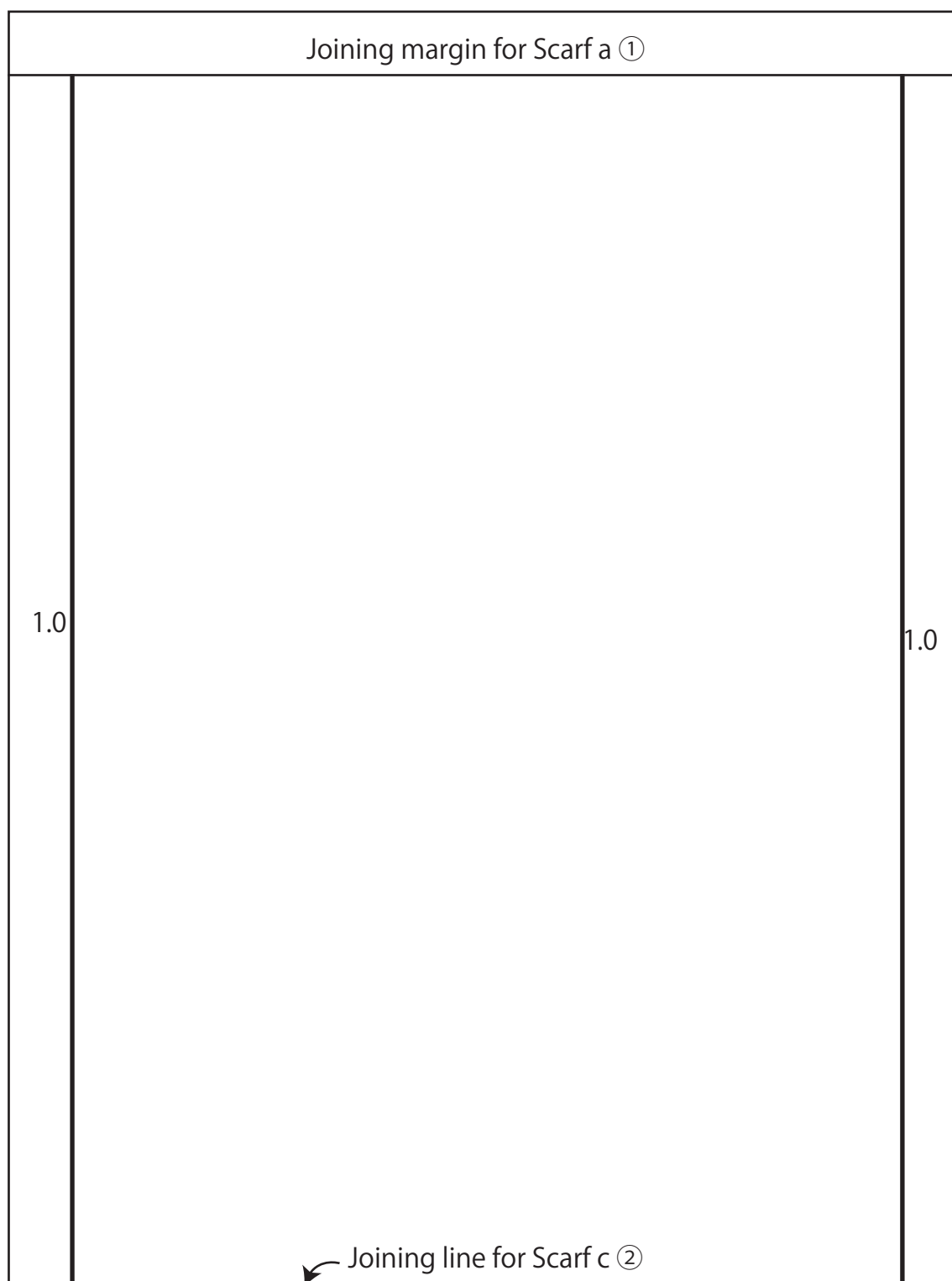


Scarf a



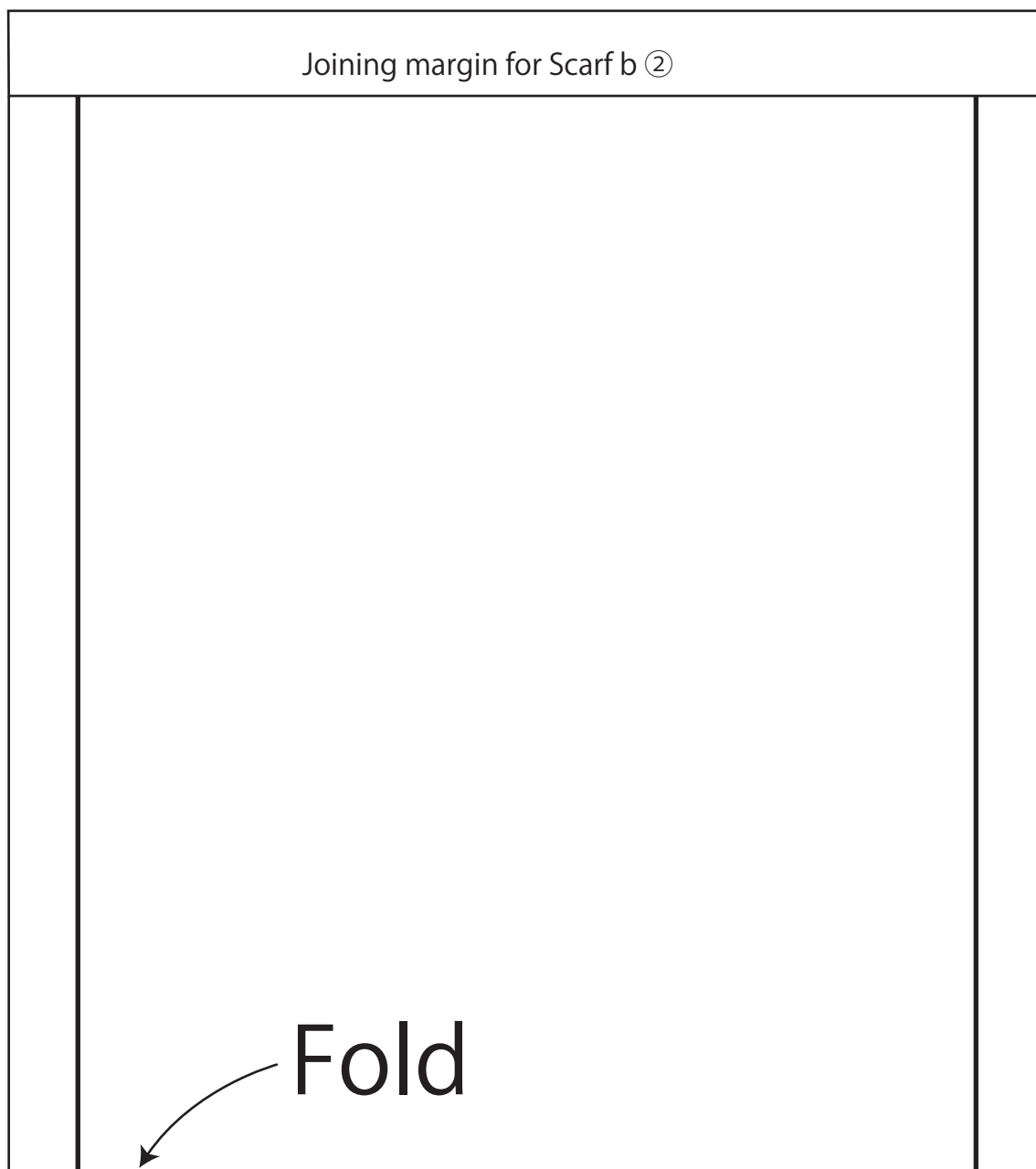
* Join Scarf a and Scarf b at the joining lines

* Join Scarf a, Scarf b and Scarf c at the joining lines ① and ② to create a single pattern.

Scarf c



* Join Scarf a, Scarf b and Scarf c at the joining lines to create a single pattern. ① and ②

★ The scarf pattern is only one half.
Cutting the fabric will be easier if you join two copies of the pattern as shown below.
